- Parking: Parking will be tight. Carpooling is appreciated. Pull all the way forward to maximize the parking spaces in the driveway. If the driveway is full, we have permission to park across the street at Yankee Kennel. Be extremely cautious crossing the road. Due to the busy traffic on the road, we do not recommend planning to crate or work out of your car. We strongly encourage you to plan to crate within the bounds of the fenced yard or in the indoor space provided.
- About the facility: This is our personal home and property. Please respect the off limits areas, and the no smoking rule. There is a human restroom in the house, it is not handicap accessible. There is a flock of ducks in a pen adjacent to the agility field.
- Dog Toileting: Plan to toilet your dog before your turn to run to reduce toileting on course. Toilet your dog in the designated areas. Clean up after your dog and deposit it in the provided receptacle
- Barking: With respect to our neighbors we need to keep barking to a minimum. Please condition your dog to be quiet in their crate prior to the workshop. If your dog is likely to bark while waiting, plan to crate them inside the indoor designated crating space. Excited barking on course is fine. Persistent barking in their crate or while waiting their turn is not.
- People & Dogs: The workshops are a time to focus on your dog and your teamwork. Respect that not all dogs may want to greet, or appreciate your dog in their personal space. Work to keep your dog's focus on you. Safety is the highest priority. If your dog doesn't appreciate dogs in their space, please tell us!
- Weather: It is summer, it will be hot. We have timed the workshops to maximize the shade in the training yard, but it is still summer, and there will be areas without shade. Please plan accordingly. Bring ample water for you and your dog, sunscreen, hat and sun glasses and be proactive to prevent heat stroke and dehydration. We will have an outdoor hose and often kiddie pool set up. If it is raining and footing is unsafe, the workshop will be canceled.
- What to Bring with you to the workshop:
  - Your dog & their agility leash/collar/gear
  - Ample treats & a couple of toys your dog loves
  - Water & dish for you and your dog
  - Your dog's crate or xpen, and a cover if appropriate
  - A chair for you (there are some plastic lawn chairs but if you want your own bring it)
  - Outdoor gear: close toed shoes, hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug spray, etc
  - Workshop specific supplies: target, mark bucket based on workshop
  - Pen & Notepad
